
GET away FROM IT ALL

Camp Glenorchy is New Zealand's first Net Zero Energy range of visitor accommodation. It's part of The Headwaters, an inspiring revitalisation of the classic camping, cabins, group gathering and retail services in the Glenorchy community.

CABINS

From creatively appointed two bedroom suites with fine linens to premium rooms with ensuite bathrooms in one, two, or three-room configurations, to affordable multi-bed bunk rooms with shared amenities, Camp Glenorchy offers flexibility and convenience for individuals, couples, families, and groups. Our well-insulated cabins harness the power of the sun to provide power and keep guests warm in winter while keeping things cool in the summer, decreasing our energy footprint and helping us use Net Zero energy each year.

To make it easy to enjoy, Camp Glenorchy features a range of all-new shared amenities such as spacious kitchen facilities with refrigerators and microwaves, as well as showers, laundry, lockers and other conveniences to help you unwind and relax in the restorative embrace of the stunning landscape that surrounds you.

SAVING energy

A mindful approach to energy use is a true part of the Camp Glenorchy experience. You control your energy efficiency yourself, when you stay in one of our cosy cabins. You'll be able to make choices about heating, lighting, shower temperature and length and then track your individual energy use through an interactive, easy-to-use in-room control panel. Cabins are connected to the guest booking system, allowing rooms to be heated only when needed and the right amount of hot water to be stored for the number of people in each room.

ENERGY

Energy-saving LED lights and resource-efficient technology and appliances are used indoors and out. The buildings are oriented to take full advantage of the sun during the day, while keeping things comfortable with extra insulation when it's cool. Energy drawn from the South Island's largest solar garden powers the buildings at Camp Glenorchy.



BUILDING FOR SUSTAINABILITY & CRAFTSMANSHIP

Our facilities are designed, built, and operated under the philosophy of the Living Building Challenge™, the most advanced environmental building design certification in the world.

Camp Glenorchy will use up to 50% less energy and water than similar facilities. Some of the innovative features you'll enjoy include:

WATER

To help reduce demand for water, underground tanks collect rainwater for use onsite. Wastewater from sinks, showers, baths, and washing machines is treated on-site using a natural system that mimics a natural wetland. State-of-the-art scent-free composting toilets further reduce water requirements.

ARTISTRY

An artist-designed campfire and BBQ shelter built with reclaimed materials and beautiful stone mosaic walkways invite guests to explore, connect and enjoy the work of talented local artists and craftspeople.

MATERIALS

Both recycled timbers and lumber sourced from Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)-certified mills have been used to build the structures at Camp Glenorchy. Non-toxic and re-used materials, either salvaged on-site or from old buildings and felled trees, mean our buildings feel inviting and familiar.

COMFORT

Walls, floors, and roofs are built to a European standard of efficiency, making rooms quiet and comfortable. Interior furniture and fittings are carefully selected to make your stay healthy, warm and welcoming.

Comfort, inspiration, and incredible beauty await you here. To help you make the most of your visit to this magical place at the head of Lake Wakatipu, we offer a wide-range of amenities and experiences for guests of all ages and groups of all sizes.
