

Construction to Begin at Camp Glenorchy

Glenorchy, New Zealand, 23 October 2015 — Earthwork and the initial stages of construction will begin next week on Camp Glenorchy, New Zealand's first NetZero Energy campground and holiday park. An agreement was reached yesterday between the owners of the former 40-year-old campground and general store in Glenorchy, and an appellant who had filed an appeal of Camp Glenorchy's Resource Consent with the Environment Court, that has cleared the way to begin construction immediately.

Camp Glenorchy, slated to open in early 2017, will provide campsites for tenting and campervans/RVs, as well as bunkhouses and accommodations amenities for up to 140 visitors.

All profits from the Camp Glenorchy and the Glenorchy Marketplace Project will flow to an independent community trust, directed by local residents, to support community projects.
